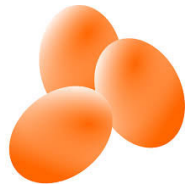
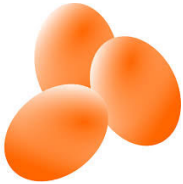
HENS FOR HAITI



OUR 5TH AND 6TH GRADE FAITH FORMATION STUDENTS ARE EARNING MONEY TO PURCHASE 100 LAYING HENS FOR HAITI.

--AN ANIMAL HUSBANDRY COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT--

- Laying hens guarantee protein for children and ensure food security for families.
- One laying hen costs \$10 and will lay 25 eggs per month for three years equaling 980 eggs.
- The commercial value of 980 eggs is \$132 so the hen produces almost 13 times its actual cost.
- The hen will eat 0.2 lbs of feed per day. Over a three-year period that equals 220 lbs per hen or 2 bags of feed for \$50.
